MINISTRY UPDATE



We are almost at the (deputation) finish line! Who knew that deputation was such a wild ride, right?

When summer started, I again thought it would be a slow season (ie. the start of my last letter in May), but God has been doing some really awesome things in my life over the past couple months! I was able to help lead a camp in Texas where we saw over 30 salvations, as well as be the speaker for two other camps in California and Missouri where we saw 9 more come to know Christ. Add that to the VBS I was a part of in Texas, and the other churches I spoke at in Oklahoma, Texas, and Arkansas this summer, hundreds of kids and families were able to hear the Gospel.

I am UNBELIEVABLY grateful for the partners in ministry I have gained this past year. The unexpected gifts, messages, and prayers that I have received have given me so much encouragement that I am on the right path. I shared with my home church some of the difficulties that come with being on the road

for deputation, but I also shared how valuable every single church and individual has been in supporting me; not just financially, but spiritually and emotionally as well.

My goal has been and still is to reach Nicaragua at the end of this year. For that to happen I am still in need of around \$1300 more per month. My fall schedule is beginning to fill up, but I would ask every person reading this to begin praying that God would provide churches and individuals who would jump on board to be a part of being FOR Nicaragua through financial support.
