In just over a year and a half, I have been able to raise even more than what I had set as my original goal! It is crazy for me to think that people trust me enough to allow me to take time out of their days and church services to share with them my burden for the people of Nicaragua to hear the Gospel (and laugh at my

jokes, which, let's be honest, are only funny half the time). It is even crazier to me to think that God put exactly the right people and churches in my path to provide the financial help I need. More, actually, than I had originally planned on raising when I began deputation.

I am wrapping up the last few speaking engagements I have booked, but, if all goes well, I will be flying out of Miami to head to Nicaragua on March 9th. My sending church, Park Crest Baptist in Springfield, MO, has been extremely generous and kind to me and is celebrating my last Sunday in the United States with me on March 6th.
